1. Chancellor Session - Kim Wilcox

Since the Chancellor (along with Maria Anguiano and Matt Hull) arrived at the meeting early, he made the attached presentation at the beginning of the meeting and answered questions. The topics discussed included:

- The grad student/BCOE faculty ratio is about 7:1; the undergrad/BCOE faculty ratio has grown from about 15:1 in FY07 to 40:1 in FY16.
- The current grad student financial incentives model could be changed in the future.
- The Provost has been obtaining additional input from BCOE faculty/staff and other constituents before re-initiating BCOE's Dean Search. The Provost is expected to name the members of the new Search Committee this week.
- The Chancellor has decided to move responsibility for A&E and Physical Plant from the VCBAS to VCRED.

2. Welcome - Request for Agenda Items from the Floor - Sharon

Nosang added the topic of furniture for the Bourns B Renovation Project.

3. Senate Update - Tom

Tom reminded participants of the Academic Senate's Divisional Meeting scheduled for tomorrow (12/6) starting at 2:10pm. Due to capacity concerns, it was suggested that this meeting be moved from the Genomics Auditorium to HUB 302.

4. Approval of minutes from October 26, 2016 Meeting - Pat

The minutes of the November 21st meeting were approved.

5. College Fall Meeting/Staff Appreciation (December 9) - Pat

Pat reminded participants that this year's BCOE Staff Appreciation event is scheduled for this Friday, December 9th starting at noon in WCH 205/206. Only 15 faculty have RSVP'd so far so he asked Chairs to encourage their faculty to RSVP as soon as possible.

6. Department Updates

MSOL: Kambiz noted the attachment to the agenda that indicated that there are 109 students in the MSOL Program; 21 are entering in Winter quarter. It was noted that there were 5 withdrawals in the Data Science and ME Specializations.

BIEN: Xiaoping reported that the department's administrative offices have been renovated. They are currently awaiting furniture.

CEE: Nosang indicated that there was a Distinguished Seminar Lecture last Friday in HUB 302. The speaker could be a good BCOE candidate. Another Distinguished Seminar Lecture is being scheduled.

CE-CERT: Matt reported that CE-CERT is participating in two of the six USDOT national center awards.

WCGEC: Reza stated that WCGEC needs to increase the number of faculty and students participating in the Center. Options that would provide financial incentives such as additional ICR return and/or lab equipment use are being developed and will be presented at a future Chairs/Directors meeting.

CSE: Marek indicated that Vassilis Tsotras has been named as the Director of the new Data Science Center. He will be invited to attend future Chairs/Directors meetings. A Data Science undergraduate program is being developed with the Statistics Department. Also, he reported that Stefano Lonardi has been named a Distinguished Member of the Association for Computer Machinery (ACM).

ME: Guillermo reported that Shane Cybart will be participating in one of UCOP's three Multi-Campus Research awards. Also, Hideaki Tsutsui will be receiving an NSF Career Award.

7. Dean's Update - Sharon

Sharon encouraged Chairs to nominate BCOE faculty for this year's Academic Senate Distinguished Teaching Award. Pertinent material for nominees will be due from departments by March 3, 2017. Also, nominations are due for the Senate's Faculty Research Lecturer award by 12/23/16.

Michalis Faloutsos is participating in the development of "Innovation Space" in the Science Library. It was noted that students should be allowed to use the equipment in the Space.

The Provost will continue to provide faculty lines for UCOP's Presidential Postdoc Fellow Program. Any resulting appointment would be additive to BCOE and not use a replacement or cluster hire line. UCOP provides salary for the appointment's first five years and \$200K in start-up funds. ME is trying to recruit one of these postdocs. Due to time constraints, the topic of furniture for the Bourns B Renovation Project was postponed to the next Chairs/Directors Meeting. No other items were discussed.











